Notes -

- 1 - The highest Division for any weapon used determines the shooters overall Division for competition, while allowing for Notes 2 & 4.
- 2 - Using and downloading high capacity magazines for Rifle and/or Pistol in the LIMITED Division is allowed.
- 3 - Excluding the OPEN Division, pistol magazines shall not exceed 6.7"/170mm for single stack mags, and shall not exceed 5.52"/140mm on double stack mags.
- 4 - If you have a 10 round capacity or less, non-optic/compensated shotgun, downloading to 7 rounds (Limited) or 9 rounds (Tactical) is allowed.
- 5 - Speedloaders* = Only the new type of shotgun speedloader is acceptable - those with the primer relief cut.
