

IDPA Match Information

IDPA matches offer **IDPA members** stages that strictly conform to IDPA rules and equipment requirements. A shooter who is not an IDPA member may shoot one IDPA match to “try it on for size”, but must join IDPA before shooting their second IDPA match or shooting the IDPA Classifier.

At registration, mark your division and classification on your score sheet.

IDPA Divisions:

- CDP Custom Defensive Pistol:** .45 ACP only, 8-rounds max in mags

- ESP Enhanced Service Pistol:** 9mm and larger single and double action autos, 10 round max in mags

- SSP Stock Service Pistol:** 9mm and larger double action and DAO autos, 10 rounds max in mags

- ESR Enhanced Service Revolver:** Revolvers shooting more powerful ammunition (usually .45 ACP or .357 Magnum), may use moon clips, 6 round maximum

- SSR Stock Service Revolver:** Revolvers typically shooting less power ammunition (usually .38 Spl), no moon clips allowed, 6-Round Max

Classifications

If you are new to IDPA or have not classified in a particular division, mark your classification as **UC – Unclassified** until you are able to shoot a Classifier for that division.

IDPA Classifications:

MA = Master SS = Sharpshooter NV = Novice
EX = Expert MM = Marksman UC = Unclassified
